Our learning structures

Our learning and teaching structure in the middle school revolves around each 'connect' class studying all curriculum areas as a group. To create structures that support middle school learner, each class will have 2 core teachers – one for English and HASS and another for Mathematics and Science. The remaining subject areas will have separate subject teachers. To support this model for Year 7 in 2023 and Year 7 and 8 in 2024, we are looking for teachers who have the skills and willingness to teach in other learning areas, as required, as the college grows.

Applicants who demonstrate a strong understanding of curriculum design and contemporary pedagogical practices underpinned by evidence based, high yield strategies are required. A thorough knowledge of the high impact teaching strategies (HITS) and the ability to enact highly effective literacy teaching practices are essential to support the School Improvement Plan (SIP). Additionally, teachers who are willing to work collaboratively in small teaching teams to ensure that our students are supported with collaboratively developed, implemented and evaluated curriculum, assessment and pedagogical strategies to enhance engagement and learning outcomes for all students.

Our culture

Supporting the development of a positive climate and culture, the ability to develop and maintain highly effective relationships with students, parents, caregivers and colleagues is essential. The successful applicant will create and maintain safe classroom environments where student voice and agency are supported and promoted to enhance learning outcomes including supporting the development of the 6C's.

Working in teams (PLC's) to develop, implement and review programs and learning outcomes is required. This includes applying learning design, assessment and moderation and a strong knowledge of the Australian Curriculum. The successful applicant will be self-reflective, share their thinking with colleagues and demonstrate the college's values.
