Travel Outcome

This travel was taken to meet with various officials in relation to the South Australian government's commitments in Reggio Emilia, Italy (including the Mayor of Reggio Emilia, and Prof Carla Rinaldi, President, Fondazione Reggio Children).

Further outcomes of the trip include speaking at a forum in the Education World Forum, London. The forum brings together delegates to debate future education policy. The 2020 theme was 'One generation – what does it take to transform education'. The event provides insight and inspiration from pioneers, policy makers and experts with many sessions given by education ministers.
