With our purpose as the anchor, the views we heard helped us make choices about what will make the biggest difference to our learners.

- We prioritised 4 interrelated areas of impact: Wellbeing, Equity and Excellence, Learner Agency and Effective Learners.
- We support and enable our staff to drive change through our system and people levers.
- Our **guiding principles** describe how we will approach our work and make decisions.

By bringing all of this together we have **Our Strategy for Public Education.**

Then we put it into action

Since the launch of Our Strategy, we've achieved a lot and we've seen brilliant work in our schools and preschools, and in our corporate offices. Our focus has been on delivering the key foundations for our ambition for public education in the long-term.

We launched a new South Australian Curriculum in our schools, and a new approach to school improvement centred around bringing Our Strategy to life in every site and driving growth.

We've introduced new tools to support learning and teaching, including our own Al initiative, EdChat, as well as improving how we do student engagement and agency.

We've implemented significant workforce reforms, improved how we invest in school infrastructure. and opened a new Technical College at Findon to prepare students for future careers.
