


Pool with no fence













Aquatic Environments - Beach Activity Sheet 3 - Swim Between the Flags

Colour in the people, then cut them out and glue them in the correct place to swim at the beach (on the picture on page 1).







Laminate the cards then cut them out.





Water Safety Tips

Home - Key Safety Tips

- Always swim with an adult.
- Enter the water safely use steps or ladders.
- Play safely around water do not push people into the pool.
- Pack away all pool toys and equipment when you have finished playing with them.
- Buckets and paddling pools should be emptied immediately after use.
- Always shut the pool gate.





Water Safety Tips

Swimming Pools/Aquatic CentresKey Safety Tips

- Always swim with an adult.
- Read and obey signs giving advice to swimmers.
- Always listen to and obey the pool lifeguards.
- Stay away from the deep end, unless you can swim well.
- Check for other swimmers before entering the water.
- Do not run around the pool edge.
- Play safely around water do not push people into the pool.
