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Examples of Practice

Adelaide High School

Students umpire and score the cricket State Carnival, having completed the level 1 umpiring course. Our students are able to put their umpiring accreditation and organisational skills into practice, whilst also achieving SACE credits

Secondary students umpire and coach at the events having completed relevant training with State Sporting Organisations.
