- This is a **count** of children in public primary schools in 2018, by year level, who live in the shared CBD zone.
- The figures go out to 2025, when **Receptions in 2018 will enter Year 7**.
- **Assumptions.** 85% of public primary school students will choose one of the CBD schools, 50 children living in the zone will enter the CBD schools from non-government schools, 130 students from out of zone will enter via special entry programs.
- **Combined zone.** This is based on a notional distribution of children in the combined zone. As ABHS cannot be expanded beyond 1250, enrolment at ABHS would need to be managed to ensure it does not exceed 1250. For illustrative purposes, in the table above, this has been shown at the end column through adjustments to the total enrolment at each school.
- **Exclusions.** This does not account for International Education Students entering the system, or the departure or entry of students into the school after Year 8 (apart from conservative projections of increased enrolment in the current Year 9 ABHS cohort).
- **Exclusions.** This does not account for children moving into the zone (increased urban density), children moving out of the zone, and increasing numbers of non-government school children choosing the CBD schools.
- **Reliability.** These figures are consistent with the lower end of the medium demand projections in an independently commissioned demographic report.
