# DAME ROMA MITCHELL SCHOLARSHIPS

**Applications** are now being called, for the Dame Roma Mitchell Scholarship, for year 10 Aboriginal students currently enrolled at your school.

The Dame Roma Mitchell scholarships have been awarded each year since 1993. They are intended to help support Aboriginal students to complete SACE.

\$2,000.00 over two years will be award to the successful students (the payment includes \$500 per semester over the two years)

Selection is based on the following application criteria and a series of indicators for each:

- **student's capacity to complete SACE:** level of achievement; consistency; attendance; skill improvement
- **school / community support:** role models/leadership; representation on committees; commitment to the community; community supportiveness
- **career aspirations:** goal setting; evidence of use of initiative; presentation/communication skills evident in writing and
- **significance of the scholarship:** evidence of usefulness and need

It is recommended that students also include in their applications, documentation of reports, awards, and evidence of participation in state, community and school events.
