

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO NEGOTIATE AN ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT UNDER THE
FAIR WORK ACT 1994**

**TO EMPLOYEES COVERED BY THE SOUTH AUSTRALIAN SCHOOL AND PRESCHOOL
EDUCATION STAFF ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT 2016**

TAKE NOTICE that the Chief Executive, Department of the Premier and Cabinet proposes to begin negotiations for a new enterprise agreement.

The proposed date and time for commencement of negotiations is Wednesday 6 June 2018 at 4pm.

The proposed place for commencement of negotiations is the Pilgrim Centre, located at the rear of 12 Flinders Street, Adelaide.


It is proposed that the enterprise agreement will bind the employees appointed pursuant to the *Education Act 1972* or the *Children's Services Act 1985* or its successor, and classified in the categories of:


- Teachers;
- Band A Leaders (Principals and Preschool Directors);
- Band B Leaders (Deputy Principals, Senior Leaders, Coordinators);
- Seconded Teachers;
- Hourly Paid Instructors;
- Pre-school Teachers (including Advanced Skills Pre-school Teachers);
- Aboriginal Community Education Workers;
- Early Childhood Workers;
- School Services Officers;
- Swimming and Aquatic Instructors.

Employees have the right to be represented in the negotiation of, and in any proceedings for the approval of, the enterprise agreement by an employee association registered under the *Fair Work Act 1994* or another agent of their choice.

Employees to be involved in these negotiations can gain access to copies of the relevant industrial instruments (i.e. *South Australian School and Preschool Education Staff Enterprise Agreement 2016* or applicable award i.e. *Teachers (DECS) Award*, *School Services Officers (Government Schools) Award*, *Pre-School (Kindergarten) Teaching Staff Award*, *Early Childhood Worker Award* or the *Aboriginal Education Workers (DECS) Award*, which currently regulate their employment by contacting the Industrial Relations Unit of the Department for Education.

Employees should note that under the *Fair Work Act 1994*, your employer is bound to provide you with a copy of your Award upon request unless you have previously requested a copy in the last 12 months, or your employer has been relieved of the obligation to provide a copy by the South Australian Employment Tribunal.
