

Service provider toolkit: RN Delegation of Care Program

The RN Delegation of Care Program works with service providers to provide safe health support to children aged under 18 years with Level 3 health support needs.

The Service Provider Toolkit contains the forms and supporting information required by the service provider to refer a child, confirm pre-requisite training, request training and assessment for health support workers, and request camp and excursion site approval by the delegating Registered Nurse (RN).
